

Four Card Frenzy

Four Card Frenzy is a house-banked, four-card poker card game played with one standard 52-card deck of playing cards. The object of the game is for the player to have a final four card hand formed from five cards dealt that is higher than the dealer's hand. Additionally, the Game offers several optional bonus wagers.

Players make 2 initial wagers of equal amounts on the "Ante" and "Odds" wagering spots, plus any optional bonus wagers. Each player will then receive five cards. After players have viewed their cards, they may choose to either fold, or place a wager on the "Raise". Players bet either 1x the "Ante" wager with a pair of Kings or lower, and up to 3x the "Ante" wager with a pair of Aces and higher. The dealer will then set their hand and compare it against all players hands.

For purposes of the Ante wager only, the dealer needs at least a king high hand to qualify.

The Ante wager pays as follows:

- Dealer does not qualify: the Ante wager pushes.
- Dealer qualifies and player wins: the Ante wager wins even money.
- Dealer qualifies and four card hands copy: the Ante wager wins even money.
- Dealer qualifies and player's hand is lower: the Ante wager loses.

The Raise wager pays as follows (regardless of Dealer qualifying):

- Player wins or copies: the Raise wager wins even money.
- Player has lower hand: the Raise wager loses.

The Odds wager pays as follows (regardless of Dealer qualifying):

- Player has straight or higher and beats or copies the dealer: Odds wager *wins*, and pays according to the Odds Win payable.
- Player has a hand of straight or higher and loses to the dealer: Odds wager *wins*, and pays according to the Odds Wager Bad Beat payable.
- Player has two pair or less and wins or copies: Odds wager pushes.
- Player has two pairs or less and loses: Odds wager loses.

Hand	Odds Pay	Bad Beat
Quad Aces	200	---
Quads 2-K	30	100
Straight Flush	15	30
Three-of-a-Kind	2	4
Flush	1.5	3
Straight	1	2
Two Pair or Less	Push	Loss

*Pays are "to 1"

Four Card Bonus

Players may place an optional bonus wager that wins if their best Four Card hand has a pair of Queens or better. The wager pays as follows:

Quads	50
Royal/Straight Flush	40
Three of a Kind	8
Flush	4
Straight	3
Two Pair	2
Pair of Queens or Better	1

*Pays are “to 1”

Prime Wager

Players win based on the number of cards in their hand composed of the same color. This bonus pays as follows:

Four out of Five Same Color	1
All Five Same Color	6

*Pays are “to 1”

Progressive Jackpot Pay Table

Players win based on their original five card hand containing one of the triggering events and pays as follows:

Royal Flush	100%
Straight Flush	1000
Four of a Kind	500
Full House	100
Flush	25
Straight	15
Three of a Kind	7

*Pays are “for 1”

Aggregate Payouts

A \$25,000 aggregate payout limit per round will apply to non-progressive wagers.
