ATTENTION GUESTS

At the Nisqually Red Wind Casino, safety is our highest priority, and we are continually seeking innovative ways to enhance the security of our guests and Team Members.

To further enhance security, we are excited to introduce a new safety feature. Starting in mid-August 2024, all Guests, Visitors, and Team Members will enter the casino through the Evolv Express system, an advanced, touchless security screening technology that uses sensor fusion and artificial intelligence (AI) to quickly and accurately detect concealed weapons.

HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS:

Evolv Express uses a combination of extremely low-frequency (ELF) radio waves and sophisticated AI to identify potential threats on an individual or in their belongings. This allows guests to walk through the system in real-time without the need to remove concealed items or separate from their personal belongings. If a potential threat is detected, the system will display an alert with a red box on a tablet, indicating the location of the item, allowing Security Officers to focus on specific areas during the secondary screening process.

As a reminder, our <u>General Rules</u> outline the restriction on weapons and the security screening requirement for all guests to enter the casino.

The Evolv Express system emits extremely low-frequency radio waves (ELF), similar to what you see in anti-theft devices in stores. You can view Evolv's Health and Safety details by clicking on this link.

FAQ

DOES THE SCREENING ALLOW SECURITY TO SEE BENEATH MY CLOTHING?

- No. The system uses built-in cameras to identify where a potential threat might be located, allowing security to conduct targeted secondary screenings.

HOW DOES THE SYSTEM PROTECT MY PRIVACY?

• The Evolv system does not store any personal information or images. All alerts are handled in real-time and are not retained after the individual has been cleared.

DOES THE SYSTEM USE FACIAL RECOGNITION?

· No. The system does not use facial recognition as part the screening.

WHAT IF I HAVE A CONCEALED WEAPONS PERMIT?

• Red Wind Casino has always had a strict no weapons policy and individuals with a concealed weapons permit are still prohibited from carrying a weapon.

DO I NEED TO REMOVE EVERYTHING FROM MY POCKETS?

• We recommend removing your mobile device and hold it in your hand as you walk through, but your keys, wallets, etc. can stay in your pockets.

DO I NEED TO PUT MY HANDS ABOVE MY HEAD TO WALK THROUGH?

· No.

DO I NEED TO TAKE MY SHOES AND JACKET OFF?

· No. You can keep your shoes and jacket on while passing through the Evolv Express system.

CAN I WEAR MY SMART WATCH/JEWELRY?

· Yes. If these items trigger an alert, you will be asked to step aside for a brief rescreening.

IS EVOLV EXPRESS SAFE FOR PREGNANT PEOPLE?

The Evolv Express uses extremely low frequency radio waves (ELF) - a non-ionizing sensing modality – in compliance with IEEE's 2019 guidance for safe operation with the general public, which they define as including pregnant people and their unborn children.

WHAT IF I DO NOT WANT TO GO THROUGH THE SYSTEM?

• We prioritize the safety of all our guests and Team Members, which is why everyone must go through the screening system before entering the casino. If you have specific health concerns, we recommend consulting your healthcare provider before your visit. Unfortunately, there are no exceptions to this requirement as it ensures a safe environment for everyone.

WILL THIS REPLACE ID SCANNING?

No, the Evolv Express system enhances our security screening process but does not replace ID checks.
Identification will still be required to enter the casino, and Security will address any alerts during the ID check process.

DO I NEED TO DO ANYTHING WHEN LEAVING THE CASINO AND EXITING THROUGH THE SYSTEM?

· No. You can proceed through the system's exit lane without needing to stop.
